

NOTICE FOR OPEN COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROGRAM FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF LARGE SCALE SOLAR PHOTOVOLTAIC PLANT (LSS) IN PENINSULAR MALAYSIA

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR SELECTION OF QUALIFIED DEVELOPERS & SITES

The Energy Commission of Malaysia (ST) is conducting a competitive bidding process to select developer(s) for the development of Large Scale Solar Photovoltaic Plant (LSS) to be located in Peninsular Malaysia. The plant will be connected to the grid and sell its energy to Tenaga Nasional Berhad (TNB) under a Power Purchase Agreement. The LSS capacity to be tendered will be from 1 MW_{ac} to 100MW_{ac}, with a target aggregate capacity of 500MW_{ac} in Peninsular Malaysia, which is expected to be commissioned in 2021.

Information on the injection points for connection to the grid will be advised upon the requisition of the RFP documents. Proposals with shallow connection will be encouraged to avoid unnecessary delays in the project implementation as well as reducing the cost of the interconnection. However, an alternative interconnection point may be offered by the bidder for consideration, subject to approval by the utility company.

ST is pleased to invite companies or consortiums with previous experience in implementing power or related projects, including project financing and operation of power plants or electrical installation, to participate in the bidding process in accordance with the criteria set forth in the Request for Proposal (RFP) document. In line with the existing Malaysian Government policy, foreign participation in a consortium shall not exceed 49%.

RFP document will be available for sale from 14th February 2019 to 27th February 2019 (9.00 am to 5.00 pm, except Saturday and Sunday) at the following address:
