Ahmad Fauzi new chairman of Energy Commission

PUTRAJAYA: Datuk Ahmad Fauzi Hasan (pictured) has been appointed as the new chairman of the Energy Commission.

His appointment is effective April 1 (Sunday).

He succeeds Datuk Abdul Razak Abdul Majid whose term as chairman ends Saturday.

The Energy, Green Technology and Water Ministry in a statement here said Ahmad Fauzi's appointment was announced by its minister Datuk Seri Dr Maximus Ongkili on

Friday.

Ahmad Fauzi, who hold a Masters in Engineering from the University of Michigan, United States, was the chief executive officer (CEO) of the Energy Commission from 2010 to 2017.

Ahmad Fauzi started his career with the commission in 2002 and had also held the posts of Director of Gas Regulation, Chief Operating Officer and Deputy CEO. —Bernama
