



‘Engage ST-registered wiring contractors’

KOTA KINABALU: Sabah Electricity Sdn Bhd (SESB) advised those who want to do internal wiring and applying for electricity supply into their premise to appoint a contractor who is competent and registered with the Energy Commission (ST).

Its acting Managing Director, Abdul Nasser Abdul Wahid, said this is important so to ensure the design, installation and electric system in compliance with the requirement set by the ST and SESB, beside for the safety reason.

He said SESB will be responsible for any losses or damages that may happen or caused during or after testing due to faulty in the internal wiring.

It is the responsibility of competent and registered electric contractor to ensure the internal wiring done is safe to use, he said,

adding the list of names of such registered contractors are available at SESB office for those applying for domestic electric supply.

He said those intending to do so can apply individually, through the appointed contractor or in group in the case of housing developer. Before the internal wiring for a house start, he said the contractor will visit the site, identify the load needed and the suitable electricity equipment to be used, to submit a plan, drawing and house specification.

For applicants who rented land or house, he said they need to firstly obtained written approval from the landlord/house owner before submit an application to SESB.

A copy of the house ownership document like land title, lease document or other similar to that can be used as a proof of ownership.
