DELEGATION OF POWERS?? WHO?





AUTHORIZED OFFICER (S. 4A, ESA 1990)

The Minister may in writing authorize any public officer or officer of the Commission to exercise the powers of enforcement under this Act.

LICENSING

(a) use, work or operate or permit to be used, worked or operated any installation; or(b) supply to or for the use of any other person electricity from any installation,

SECTION 9(1)

Exemption:

- 1) Generator below 5kW for personal use *[Electricity Supply (Exemption) Notification 1994: P.U. (B) 156]
- Solar installation ≤ 72kW for 3 φ and ≤ 24kW for 1φ. *[Exemption Under Section 54: P.U.(B)342]

REGISTRATION OF INSTALLATIONS

REQUIREMENTS: SECTION 21

- (1) No person shall possess or operate an installation, unless the installation is registered on a valid Certificate of Registration.
- (2) Installations which are subject to this provision:
 - receives energy from a licensee at a voltage of 11 kV or more; or

1.	Overall Wiring (Single Phase or Three Phase)	100mA (0.1A)	Mandatory
2.	Final Circuit for Power (13A socket outlets)	30mA (0.03A)	Mandatory
3.	Wet places (toilets and wet kitchens) /Water heater circuits	10mA (0.01A)	Mandatory

ELECTRICITY THEFT



SECTION 37(1)

Any person who tampers with or adjusts any installation or part thereof or manufactures or imports or sells any equipment so as to cause or to be likely to cause danger to human life or limb or injury to any equipment or other property...

on conviction, be liable to a fine not exceeding one million ringgit or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding ten years or to both.

Electricity Supply Act 1990

SECTION 37(3)

(3) Any person who in any manner dishonestly—

- a) abstracts electricity;
- b) consumes electricity;
- c) uses electricity;
- alters the index of any meter or other instrument used on or in connection with any installation of any supply authority or any licensed installation for recording the output or consumption of electricity; or
- e) prevents any such meter or instrument from duly recording the output or consumption of electricity,

SECTION 37 (14)

Any person who damages any meter or other instrument used on or in connection with any licensed installation, for recording the output or consumption of electricity shall be guilty of an offence and shall, on conviction, be liable to a fine not exceeding fifty thousand ringgit or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years or to both









ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES



ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES

- 1) 34 categories of electrical appliances are currently being regulated by ST.
- 2) Requirements to obtain CoA (reg.97, PPE1994) and SIRIM-ST label (reg. 98, PPE1994)
- 3) General penalty under reg. 122, PPE1994: Fine not exceeding RM 5, 000-00 or imprisonment not exceeding 1 year or both.

ONLY APPLICABLE TO INSTALLATION...

whose total electrical energy consumption over any period not exceeding six consecutive months equals to or exceeds 3,000,000 kWh





NOTIFICATION BY THE COMMISSION

.....

Reg 6(1), EMEER 2008

The Commission may, at any time by written notice, direct any private installation licensee or consumer to appoint or designate a registered electrical energy manager



GENERAL PENALTY

(Reg 22, EMEER 2008)



Any person who commits an offence under these Regulations shall, on conviction, be liable to a fine not exceeding five thousand ringgit or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or to both.
