ST Publishes Piped Gas Distribution Industry Statistics 2016

Putrajaya, 1 November - The Energy Commission (ST) recently published the Piped Gas Distribution Industry Statistics 2016, a comprehensive data and statistics regarding the piped gas industry in Malaysia for year 2016.

The 78-pages book gives a background of the industry, the gas consumption by different categories and sectors, the supply reliability and service quality as well as tariff and prices.

It also includes the financial performance of gas utility, gas licensees, gas reticulation system approvals, gas fitting, gas appliance and gas equipment approvals, gas safety audits, gas accidents and related guidelines or circulars.

This handbook is a comprehensive compendium of our national gas sector. It serves as a general reference to policy makers, public and private organisations, students and the public.
